

The Colours of The Association

In 1894 the colours were stated as 'Amber and Black'. With the re-establishment of the association in 1925 the same colours were again named. In 1950, with a revision of the constitution, the colours were changed to 'Amber, Green and Black'. No reason was given for the change.

The Association's Monogram

Prior to 1964 the association's monogram and cap badge were the initials TCA in amber on a black background. In 1964 the coat of arms of the Earls of Egmont, stylised and in amber and green colours on a black background, were adopted for the association's monogram and cap badge. The motto 'Sub Cruce Candida' translates as 'under the white cross'.
